- LANGØYA.

- 1-2. Trenches and M.G. positions. The layout of these trenches is approximately shown by the lines, and the firing direction by the arrows. In front of trench no. 1 there is a small hutment.
3. Small hutment.
4. M.G. nests.
- There is a telephone cable from this island to the W/P at Lofthus. It is reported that the previous watchpost left the island in Summer 1943.
- BJØRKEDALSVATN.

1. 5 M.G. nests sited north of the main road, covering the road from Kr. sand S.
2. Pillbox.
3. 3 M.G. nests south of the main road, covering the road from Lunteviken.
4. Electrical power line.

8. Trenches blasted into the rock, with one M.G. position. The firing direction is shown by the arrows.
9. Trench with one M.G. position. The firing direction is shown by the arrows.
10. 2 - 75 mm. field guns, covering the approaches to Lillesand.
11. Watch post. One guard hut. On the roof of the hut one twin-barrelled A.A. M.G. Telephone cable to Langøya (see above).
- STENE.

15. Construction work on pillboxes is going on along the railway line (Flakevatn railway) from Stene St. and south-eastwards to Lillesand.

- M.G. nests along the shore at the eastern side of the harbour. It is also reported that there are several M.G. nests, ammunition shelters and barbed wire on knife rests in readiness in the town, but details are not known. There are no reports about any requisitioned buildings in the town. The Orstekommandants office is in the camp at Vestre Moland. (See below).
